*Hi, I'm the large yellow sign that you can't miss on Highway 6, 9kms east of Vernon.*

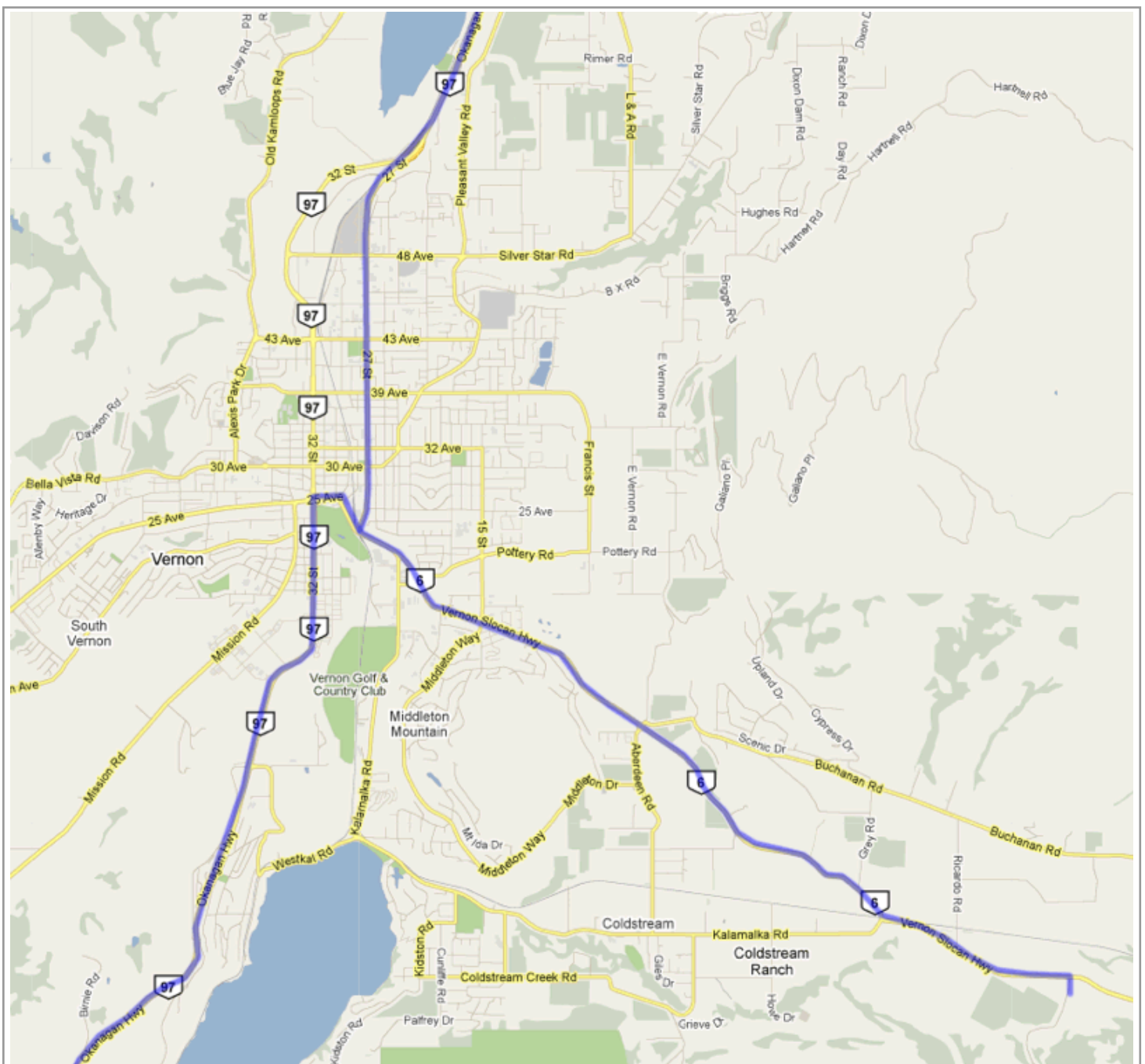

## Arriving in Vernon from the North

When entering Vernon from the North on Highway 97, take the road under the overpass, this is 27th Street. Follow 27th Street all the way to where it meets and turns into Highway 6, follow Highway 6 for 8.5kms East to the huge yellow sign at King Eddy Forest Service Road.

## Arriving in Vernon from the South

When entering Vernon from the South on Highway 97, turn right onto 25th Avenue at the bottom of the large hill, turn right at the next intersection onto Highway 6 and follow 8.75kms East to the huge yellow sign at King Eddy Forest Service Road.

## Bear Creek Kelowna from the North

Drive through Kelowna and across the bridge, take the first right at the top of the hill onto Westside Road. Follow Westside Road for 16.5kms then turn left onto Lambly Creek/Bear Creek FSR, drive 8kms then turn right when you see the Lower Pits sign and continue another couple kms to the Lower Pits parking area.

## Bear Creek Kelowna from the South

As your driving through West Kelowna (previously Westbank) you will need to turn left onto Westside Road. Follow Westside Road for 16.5kms then turn left onto Lambly Creek/Bear Creek FSR, drive 8kms then turn right when you see the Lower Pits sign and continue another couple kms to the Lower Pits parking area.
